# The NTC 10 & Under Junior Excellence Program

The prerequisite for participation in the **Orange/Green 10 & Under Junior Excellence** program is as follows:

- Must be an NTC Junior Member (\$175 for the season ending May 31, 2015)
- Must have the free 10 & under USTA membership
- Must be enrolled in 2+ days/week of the Orange/Green Junior Excellence drills (listed below)
- Must participate in NTC's USTA Junior Team Tennis
- Must compete in a minimum of one USTA tournament per month

#### Orange Ball Level:

Players at the Orange ball level are already able to play matches using orange balls on the 60 foot court. Players can rally, serve, and apply basic strategies to illustrate point construction. These athletes demonstrate proper form and a high level of dedication to the extra commitment that competitive training requires.

#### Green Ball Level:

Pro approval required, along with the same expectations as outlined for the Orange level. Additionally, players at the Green ball level are able to compete on their own while consistently demonstrating good physical, technical, tactical, and mental training.

### **USTA JUNIOR TEAM TENNIS (JTT)**

As part of the competitive training required in the 10 & Under junior tennis pathway, NTC will be fielding a USTA Junior Team. This exciting program requires a USTA membership (free in 2014 to players under the age of 10). Players will have both home and away matches, traveling to competitions with NTC staff pros. JTT encourages healthy competition, while at the same time fostering a spirit of teamwork.

**Refund policy:** Fees are non-refundable except as follows. A pro-rated credit shall be issued to a student who is asked to withdraw from a class due to not meeting level requirements. A credit less a 10% admin charge will be issued for either: 1) medical reasons (credit issued from notification date of doctor verified injuries of 4 weeks or longer), 2) to a student who drops a class before the start of a session, 3) to a student from the date they are replaced in a class. There are no refunds for tournament absences.

Junior Excellence participants are allowed one free make-up per Fall and Spring sessions; two make-ups during the Winter session.
